The kitchen is generous with s/s gas cooktop, s/s electric oven, s/s dishwasher. Upstairs the 3rd bedroom has a 2nd sitting room with r/c split system. Adjoining the home is a large double carport, plus a 7m x 6m double garage, there is a 9 x 18m shed with concrete floor and power connected to both sheds and the large shed has 15amp power.
